NOTES on use of Report Forms

This form is for use by Ramblers members who come across an open access problem in North Wales Area
These forms can be used for Requesting a Crossing Point, Requesting access to Open Access Land, and/or Requesting a Review of Incorrectly Mapped Open Access Land
Community – put in here the Community or Town Council if known
Route taken – put this in to show the Access Authority the reason why a crossing point would be useful
Access Authority – write in or circle the relevant access authority if known
Wall/fence/hedge – circle as appropriate
Map Reference – put in a 6 figure reference if known, otherwise describe the location e.g. 150 metres south east from Bryn Mawr Farm
Proposal for stile/gate – circle which you think is most appropriate.
Name of access area on map – put in here the nearest name on the OS 1:25,000 map
Map reference of centre of parcel – put in a 6 figure reference
Access problem, Access needs improving – circle yes or no in each case
Suggested solution - Write in here what you consider to be the best way of accessing the parcel e.g. from such and such a farm, or from an adjacent right of way.
Approximate area of parcel – make the best estimate you can of the area of the parcel in question.
